New Business:

Choose Barn Benefit Projects – The projects talked about for included

1. Beef Scale – It will cost between \$3,000-\$5,000 Sean and Steven are both going to look into the cost and what needs to be done
2. Sheep Show Ring – Putting decomposed granite on as a base in the show ring. Possibly pull out the permanent railing/fence around the ring out and put in removable panels to make it easier for the sale seating. It was discussed that Gary Olson should be asked if he would like to sponsor part of this. The labor for the ring could be provided by JLA and community members. Deanna and Ray are going to look into this project.
3. Sheep Scale, build a new cage around the scale. Deanna, Ray and Yvette all looked at the scale and are going to make a plan for a new one.
4. Electrical in the sheep area – We probably need new breakers depending on the price we can get some with what is left over for the year.
5. Water hoses leak in the swine and sheep area.
6. Fan by the sell ring goes off and on.
7. Panels – It was discussed buying panels with the left over money to replace some of the permanent pens. Two other ways of getting more panels was discussed.
 - a. Get other panels sponsored and put their name on them or in an area.
 - b. Allow the kids to buy a buyers gift in their buyer's name as their gift. A plan was created to make this happen. Forms will be made giving the kids options to buy \$25, \$50, ect gifts. The forms will be filled out and the money turned into the livestock auction. The JLA will collect the forms and money and make sure they are filled out with all the proper information for the buyer's receipt. The money will then be collected in a lump sum each night and brought to the front fair office. Forms will be handed out at the scales and explained.

Ag License Plates – Andree’ – Las Plumas FFA gave a presentation about the new Ag License plates and how the money from the registration for these plates goes to the Agriculture programs.
