

## **IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE 2011 EXHIBITOR'S GUIDE BOOK**

### **LOCAL RULES**

1. Page 9 - Breeding Livestock Exhibitors there will be NO first bedding.
2. Page 10 - No vehicles will be allowed on the grounds after 7:30 a.m. each morning.
3. Page 10 - (TRAILERS) Pre-Registration for returning trailers is May 2nd, all new trailers may register for a place May 9th.
4. Page 10 - Passes will be distributed as follows. Each youth exhibitor will receive 1 exhibitor pass, 1 parent pass and 1 parking passes. Each open exhibitor will receive 2 exhibitor passes and 1 parking pass.
5. Page 11- Tail dock check will be one day only on June 18th from 9am to 12 noon.
6. Page 11 - Distribution of Auction Checks—**This year auction checks will be given to advisors or leaders after pens and equipment areas have been cleaned**, advisors/leaders will be responsible for collecting “thank you cards”.

### **LIVESTOCK**

1. Breeding stock needs to be in place and trailers removed by 7:30 a.m. Thursday, August 25.
2. FFA and 4-H breeding shows will be combined for all species.
3. Market animal entry \$20.
4. Barn fees have been eliminated.
5. Bred & Owned has been changed to a pre-entry class with an entry fee of \$10.
6. Bred & Owned Definition: The owner of a “bred and owned” animal is the person owning the dam of the animal at the time of conception.
7. NO TOP WEIGHT ON STEERS, SHEEP, HOGS, OR GOATS
8. Beef Replacement Heifer Division will be added for the 2012 Fair. Rules are available on page 12. A replacement heifer takes the place of a market animal, you **may not sell** a market animal and a replacement heifer in the same year. Rules are subject to change for the 2012 fair.
