

## BUCKET CALF & BUMMER LAMB PROJECT

1. Pre-entry is not required. Exhibitors must be on hand when class is called.
2. The exhibition and judging will begin at 5 p.m. with the Bucket Calf Class followed by Bummer Lamb Class - Saturday, August 27, 2011.  
**See livestock office for final show schedule.**
3. Animals cannot be brought to the Fair prior to 3 p.m. on Saturday, August 27, 2011. Animals will not be kept at the fairgrounds. They must be removed the same day that judging is held. No pens are available.
4. No cash awards will be given. Participation ribbons will be awarded to all participants
5. The Bucket Calf and Bummer Lamb Projects are for youth 5 years to 9 years old. Exhibitors shall not have passed their 10th birthday by January 1 of the current year.
6. Exhibitors must own or care for calf or lamb at least 60 days prior to the Fair of the current year. Animal does not have to be owned by the exhibitor, but it must be in the care of the exhibitor.
7. There is no sale of bucket calves or bummer lambs at the Junior Livestock Auction.
8. Even though this is not a competitive division, the judge will be looking at the overall grooming of the animal, (lamb may be unshorn or shorn) soundness of the animal, ability of the youth to lead and control animal, knowledge by youth of feeding and other animal facts and the neat appearance of the youth.
9. Bucket Calf and Bummer Lamb Projects are designed to be a cooperative project involving the entire family. It is not intended to be a competitive-oriented market class animal project. This is not a 4-H sponsored event.

## PORKER SHOWMANSHIP

1. Pre-entry is not required. Exhibitors must be on hand when class is called.
2. The exhibition and judging will be held at 7 p.m. (after Supreme showmanship) on Saturday, August 27, 2011 in the Cassidy Arena. **See Livestock Office for final show schedule.**
3. No cash awards will be given. Participation ribbons will be awarded to all participants.
4. The Porker Showmanship class is for youth 5 years to 9 years old. Members shall not have passed their 10th birthday by January 1 of the current year.
5. Exhibitors shall show an animal already on the grounds and entered in a class at the Fair. Animals shall be appropriate and suitable for a youth exhibitor between the ages of 5 and 9 years old. No boars.
6. Exhibitors shall have had the opportunity to work with the animal of choice prior to the Fair, August 25, 2011.
7. Even though this is not a competitive division, the judge will be looking at the overall grooming of the animal, soundness of the animal, ability of the youth to lead and control animal, knowledge by youth of feeding and other animal facts and the neat appearance of the youth.
8. Porker Showmanship is intended to be a learning experience that involves the family of the youth, and is not intended to be a competitive program. The emphasis is on the experience and education. This is not a 4-H sponsored event.
