### REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDING ANIMALS

4-H and FFA Breeding Animals will be judged together.

Registry in appropriate associations is required for entry. BEEF CATTLE - all females 24 (twenty-four) months of age or older at the beginning day of the fair must : a) have a calf at side; b) show obvious signs of pregnancy; or c) have a veterinarian's certificate of pregnancy. Note: Nurse cows will not be permitted on the fairgrounds. First bedding will not be provided for breeding animals. If there is a sufficient number of any one breed in the "All Other Breeds" Division, a separate division may be established.

**Wednesday, AUGUST 24, 2010, 5:30 p.m.**  
**ALL MARKET BEEF MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY OWNED BY THE**  
**EXHIBITOR FOR AT LEAST 120 DAYS PRIOR TO THE OPENING DAY OF THE**  
**FAIR. 4-H AND FFA MARKET CLASSES WILL NOT BE COMBINED.**

All breeds judged together - Danish system of judging. One entry per exhibitor. No substitutions after entry. Market classes are limited to bona fide members of FFA Chapters or 4-H Clubs in Butte County or as provided for in the State Rules. It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made in Federal grading.

#### GRADE:

**Market Ready:** Market steers projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice or Select+ quality grades. **Blue Ribbon - Eligible for sale**

**Not Market Ready:** Market steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select - or lower. **Red Ribbon - Not eligible for sale.**

After weighing, market steers may be divided into weight lots desired by management for convenience in judging. If packing house permits - Carcass Contest - Eligible Market Beef Animals will automatically be included. Additional prize money will be sponsored by the Butte County Cattlemen's Association.

**Entry Fee: \$20.00 per entry per class**

- Junior Get of Sire: To consist of three animals; senior yearlings or younger, one of which have freshened, either sex, the get of the same sire. Must be identified by registration number. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry sired by the bull
  - Best of Three Females—Any age, all bred by exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
  - Produce of Dam: To consist of two animals, any ages, either sex, the produce of one cow. The dam must be identified by registration number.
  - Young Herd: One bull, two heifers senior yearlings or younger. Heifers must have been bred by exhibitor.

Champion and Reserve Champion Bull and Female

**An additional premium of \$4.00 will be paid for females in the individual classes that have been met by the following requirements.**

Only records shown on Dairy Herd Improvement Registry Certificates, or Dairy Herd Improvement Association (official plan) records, which are supervised and approved by the State of California Ag. Extension Service, will be accepted and must be submitted to management along with registration certificates as required by state rules. (Certified excerpts containing all necessary information will be acceptable) The record of production must meet the minimum pounds of butterfat listed below and be based on the current age of the cow.

Senior and Junior Yearlings in milk must be shown with 2 year olds in both individual and group classes. **NOTE: "In Milk" must appear on your entry form.**
