

## FFA & 4-H POULTRY & WATERFOWL DIVISIONS

EACH EXHIBITOR LIMITED TO 4 ANIMALS PER DIVISION

**As a result of the Exotic Newcastle Disease quarantine release and to prevent future outbreaks of the disease, all fairs are required to have poultry inspections upon arrival at the fair prior to coop-in for symptoms of disease or illness. Any suspected animals may be dismissed from the fairgrounds. (Dept. of Food & Ag. Memo F2004-05, F2005-06 & F2007-03)**

Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Official Show Rules and the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Association, Inc. shall apply to the Butte County Fair poultry shows, except in such instances where they are in conflict with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.

- Birds will be shown and judged in the proper divisions and class for breed, variety, age and sex ONLY. If no class is offered, no award may be made. Disqualified birds and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
- A judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition, but the bird shall be counted as an entry.
- For all classes of standard-bred chickens, turkeys, ducks, and geese, all birds must be identified by the leg bands conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show.

## FFA & 4-H POULTRY MEAT PEN

All Breeds judged together—Entry Fee \$20.00

Limit: one entry per exhibitor

Due to required health inspection receiving of poultry meat pens are only the following time: Wednesday, August 24, 2011 - 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

- Only top five (5) placing market ready poultry meat pens will be allowed to sell in the Junior Livestock Auction. (This includes the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion pens)
- Pens will be sold by the lot, not the pound.
- See Junior Livestock Auction Rule #1 for participation restrictions.
- Exhibitor must be 9 as of January 1, 2011.
- State, Local and Auction Rules apply.
- Poultry showmanship to be held prior to meat pen judging.
- See local rules page 10 for uniform requirements.
- Meat pen poultry must be owned at least 30 days prior to opening day of the fair. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the project for a minimum of 60 days prior to the fair.
- Auction participants are limited to ONE market animal entry or meat pen entry.
- Meat pen is made up of three (3) chickens of same age and breed cooped together. Chickens must be at least 42 days old and no more than 70 days old. Minimum weight for each chicken should be 3.5 pounds with a maximum of 6.0 pounds.
- Meat pen birds may not be entered in other classes.
- Meat pen seller must make arrangements to process meat pen per desired wishes of buyers and deliver chickens to buyer. Read Auction Rule #16.
- Judging of the meat pens will take place on Thursday, August 25th beginning at 7 p.m. Meat pens will be weighed prior to judging. **EXHIBITOR MUST BE PRESENT FOR JUDGING OR MEAT PEN WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

### DIVISION 4150 \_\_\_\_\_ FFA & 4-H POULTRY MEAT PEN

Class

1 Poultry Meat Pen

Three (3) chickens of same age, 3.5 pounds to 6.0 pounds—42 to 70 days old. MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN ANY OTHER CLASS.

**(This class may be cancelled if there are fewer than (3) Meat Pens entered by (3) different exhibitors.)**
