REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDING ANIMALS

4-H and FFA Breeding Animals will be judged together. Registry in appropriate associations is required for entry. Flock numbers shall be used to identify all entries. Numbers shall be on regular and practical tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear for Yearlings and Lambs bred by the exhibitor, except for National Suffolk Sheep Association, in which case their registration ID requirements will be followed. LAMBS MUST SHOW LAMB'S TEETH. If there is a sufficient number of any one breed in the "All Other Breeds" Division, a separate division may be established.

Limit: 2 entries per class per exhibitor.

FFA & 4-H MARKET LAMB DIVISIONS

ALL MARKET LAMBS WILL ONLY BE RECEIVED AT THE FOLLOWING TIMES:

Wednesday, August 24th from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

SCRAPIE TAGS MUST BE IN THE EARS OF THE ANIMALS AND ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED IN PRIOR TO UNLOADING.

There will be one tail check day.

ALL MARKET ANIMALS MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY OWNED BY THE EXHIBITOR FOR AT LEAST 60 DAYS PRIOR TO THE OPENING DAY OF THE FAIR. 4-H AND FFA MARKET CLASSES WILL NOT BE COMBINED. Scrapie Certification program see State Rule X #1 Sheep & Goat Health Rules.

All breeds judged together - Danish system of judging. One entry per exhibitor. No substitutions after entry. Lambs will be "slick shorn" no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the Fair. Wool will be permitted below the hocks and on the head. No wool on the buttocks. Market classes are limited to bona fide members of FFA Chapters or 4-H Clubs in Butte County, or as provided for in the State Rules. It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made to the Federal grading.

GRADE

Market Ready: USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .16-.35, average or greater conformation and cutability. **Blue Ribbon - Eligible for sale.**

Not Market Ready: Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.16 or>.35; unfinished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability. **Red Ribbon - Not Eligible for sale.**

After weighing, market lambs may be divided into weight lots as desired by management for convenience in judging.
