READ 2010 STATE RULES, PRINTED IN THE FRONT OF THE BOOK, REGARDING HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR BREEDING SWINE.

4-H and FFA Breeding Animals will be judged together. Registry in appropriate associations is required for entry. Sows, June Yearlings, or older, must have raised a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry. Gilts entered in the market hog divisions may not be entered in the breeding divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair. If there is a sufficient number of any one breed in the "All Other Breeds" Division, a separate division may be established. Draw ear notchings on entry form. DO NOT USE NUMBERS TO IDENTIFY NOTCHINGS. (Use the division number on the entry form to designate breed. Use the same class numbers listed below for all divisions.)

DIVISION 4040 FFA & 4-H UNREGISTERED SWINE

1. Signature on entry form certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the Unregistered classes was registered or purebred.
2. Animals must be ear notched. Draw ear notches on entry form. Animals that have been Registered by a Purebred association cannot be entered in the unregistered Classes.
3. All other Rules and regulations apply.
4. Grade crossbreds and Unregistered Purebred swine will be judged strictly on a grade hog basis. Limit 2 entries per class per exhibitor.

ALL MARKET SWINE MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY OWNED BY THE
 EXHIBITOR FOR AT LEAST 60 DAYS PRIOR TO THE OPENING DAY OF THE
 FAIR. 4-H AND FFA MARKET CLASSES WILL NOT BE COMBINED.

All breeds judged together - Danish system of judging. One entry per exhibitor. No substitutions after entry. Market classes are limited to bona fide members of FFA Chapters and 4-H Clubs in Butte County or as provided for in the State Rules. It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made in Federal grading.

GRADE

Market Acceptable: U. S. No.1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

Blue Ribbon - Eligible for sale.

Not Market Acceptable: Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. number 3, U.S. number 4 and utility grade hogs. **Red Ribbon - Not eligible for sale.** After weighing, market hogs may be divided into weight lots desired by management for convenience in judging.

Bred and Owned Definition: The owner of a "bred and owned" animal is the owner of the dam of the animal at the time of conception.
