One Day Carry-on Cage Show

1. State and local rules apply - this is not an ARBA sanctioned show. See uniform requirement on page 10.
2. All animals must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same show must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
2. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper show and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no show is offered no awards may be made. Rabbits that are disqualified because of permanent defects, deformities or blemishes, and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
3. The age in months (4 months, etc.) must be entered on the entry form for each animal entered in the breed divisions.
4. Breed, variety and I.D. number must appear on the entry forms. ANIMALS MUST BE SHOWN IN THE APPROPRIATE DIVISION.
5. No does with litters.
6. All rabbits should be healthy and free from lice, mites and disease. Sick animals will be removed from the fairgrounds. No exceptions.
7. Exhibitors must have carry cages for their entries. Cages will not be provided.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing one frozen liter water bottle for each rabbit in case of extreme heat.
9. Exhibitors must be present during judging.
10. Rabbit entries open to youth ages 5 (as of January 1, 2011) and are eligible to compete exhibit through December 31st of the year in which they reach age 19. (Meat pen exhibitors must be 9 as of January 1, 2011).
11. Incomplete and entry forms missing information will not be accepted. Entry fees must accompany form. State and local rules apply.
12. All animals must have been shown and qualified in breed classes to be eligible for Fur/Wool classes. Disqualified or eliminated animals cannot compete in Fur/Wool Classes.
13. Entries will be separated into breeds and classes after entries close. Showmanship class will be held prior to breed class judging.

Entry Fee: \$ 2.00 per entry per class

Limit per class: none - State & Local Rules Apply

All Breeds judged together - Entry Fee: \$ 20.00 Limit: one entry per exhibitor
Meat Pens received: Wednesday, August 24, 2011(8 a.m. - 10 a.m.) Must be place by 10 a.m.

- 1 Only market ready rabbit meat pens will be allowed to sell in the Junior Livestock Auction.
- 2 Pens will be sold by the lot, not by the pound.
- 3 See Junior Livestock Auction Rule #1 for participation restrictions.
- 4 Exhibitor must be 9 as of January 1, 2011
- 5 State, Local, and Auction Rules apply.
- 6 Meat pen seller must make arrangements to process meat pen per desired wishes of buyers and deliver rabbits to buyer. Read Auction Rule #16.
- 7 Rabbit Showmanship to be held prior to meat pen judging.

DIVISION 4200 _____ FFA & 4-H RABBIT MEAT PEN

Class

- 1 Rabbit Meat Pen - Three Rabbits, 3 lbs. to 5 lbs. - not over 70 days old. Each entry to be of one breed and color. **MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN ANY OTHER CLASS. (This class may be cancelled if there are fewer than (3) Meat Pens entered by (3) different exhibitors.)**
