Old Business:

1. Fundraiser Dinner:

a. Info: Saturday, March 17th. Time: Doors open at 6pm and dinner at 7pm. \$125 per couple

b. Dinner Menu – Tina moved to have beef as the first meat and pork as the second, Kathy seconded the motion. Motion passed. The food committee was discussed and it was mentioned that Deanna would like to have a committee put together. Andree' moved to put together a committee chosen by Deanna, Steven seconded the motion and the motion passed.

c. Drink Sponsors – Ashley will check with Jones Flying Service to see if they want to sponsor, Sean will talk to DBI and Foothill distributors and see if they would sponsor. Steven and Melissa will talk to Jose from Casa Lupe and ask for a donation.

Ticket Sales – Ticket were dispersed throughout the JLA committee, and after going through the list and figuring out who had been talked to and still needed tickets the committee has all the tickets accounted for and no advertisement is needed. Those who would like to come, but do not have a ticket need to call the fair office and Christy will put them on a waiting list. 2. Livestock Schedules – Was passed by the Board. The schedule will be emailed out for continuing revision.

3. Old Guidebooks – Recommended changes were made to the following:

a. Steven moved to raise commission by 1% and raise entry fees to \$25. Motion was seconded by Ashleigh. Andree' moved to amend the motion by striking out \$25 and inserting \$20, seconded by Ashleigh. Motion to amend passed. The main motion was voted on and passed. Making the new recommendation for commissions for goats, sheep, swine, poultry and rabbits 8% and for steers 4.25%. The recommended entry fee will be 20%

b. Ashleigh moved to have the sale of champions at 1pm, Tina seconded, motion passed.

Natalie moved to combine the FFA and 4-H breeding shows, Andree' seconded the motion, motion passed.

Recommended changes made without Motions:

d. Entry fees will not be refunded after entry closing date.

e. First bedding will not be provided for any exhibitor.

f. No vehicles allowed on the grounds after 7:30am (Due to shows starting earlier.

Passes will be given as follows:

Youth exhibitors shall receive one exhibitor pass, one parent pass and one parking pass

Open exhibitors shall receive two exhibitor passes and one parking pass

h. Voluntary tail dock will be changed to one day.

i. A credit card will be put on file for all buyers when they register, and will be used after 30 days if the bill is not paid. Non-profits in good standing will not be required to have a credit card on file.

j. Checks will be available after 10am, and only after the pens are cleaned and a thank you note is received.

k. Bred and owned should become a pre-entry class, and clarification and rules shall be included.
