CHAMPIONS - RIBBONS

Rules:

1. Registry in appropriate breed associations is required for entry.
2. Flock numbers shall be used to identify all entries.
3. Numbers shall be on regular and practical tag attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear. An exhibitor may not use the same flock number on more than one animal during two consecutive calendar years.
4. Identification program State Rule X #1 Sheep & Goat Health Rules.
5. Flock numbers and breeder's initials, name, or association prefix shall be on regular and practical tags attached to the ear for Yearlings and Lambs bred by the exhibitor, except for National Suffolk Sheep Association, in which case their registration ID numbers will be followed.
6. All State and Local rules apply.

12. Pair of Yearlings Ewes: Two yearling ewes.

WHETHER DAM –WHETHER SIRE

Rules: Limit: 2 Entries Per Class Per Exhibitor

1. A permanent ear tag or tattoo is required.
2. Identification program State Rule X#1 Sheep & Goat Health.
3. All State and Local rules apply.
4. Animals cannot be entered or shown in the registered classes.

DIVISION 713 _____ **WHETHER DAM –WHETHER SIRE SHEEP**

Class

1. Ewes... all lambs will be weight during weigh ins and split into classes by weight.
2. Rams... all lambs will be weight during weigh ins and split into classes by weight.

GROUPS: ALL OWNED BY ONE EXHIBITOR AND ENTERED AS INDIVIDUALS. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE ONE BREED.

9. Flock: One yearling or ram lamb, two yearling ewes and two ewe lambs.
10. Get of Sire: Four sheep, sired by the same ram.
11. Young Flock: One ram lamb and two ewe lambs.
12. Pair of Ram Lambs: Two ram lambs.
13. Pair of Ewe Lambs: Two ewe lambs.
14. Pair of Yearlings Ewes: Two yearling ewes.
