## Rules:

- 1. State and local rules apply.
- 2. All animals must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same show must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
- 3. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper show and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no show is offered no awards may be made. Rabbits that are disqualified because of permanent defects, deformities or blemishes, and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
- 4. The age in months (4 months, etc.) must be entered on the entry form for each animal entered in the breed divisions.
- 5. Breed, variety and I.D. number must appear on the entry forms. ANIMALS MUST BE SHOWN IN THE APPROPRIATE DIVISION.
- 6. No does with litters.
- All rabbits should be healthy and free from lice, mites and disease. Sick animals will be removed from the fairgrounds. No
  exceptions.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing one frozen liter water bottle for each rabbit in case of extreme heat.
- 9. Exhibitors must be present during judging.
- 10. Rabbit entries open to youth 5 years old (as of January 1, 2019). Youth remain eligible to compete through December 31 of the year in which they reach age 19. (Meat pen exhibitors must be 9 as of January 1, 2019).
- 11. All animals must have been shown and qualified in breed classes to be eligible for Fur/Wool classes. Disqualified or eliminated animals cannot compete in Fur/Wool Classes.
