ENTRY LIMITS FOR LAMBS IS 120

Limit: 1 Entry Per Class Per Exhibitor

Entry Fee: \$20.00 Per Entry

No Cash Awards - Ribbons Only

Rules:

1. Only market ready market lambs will be allowed to sell in the Junior Livestock Auction.
2. Identification program see State Rule X #1 Sheep & Goat Health Rules.
3. All breeds judged together - Danish system of judging.
4. Lambs will be “slick shorn” no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the Fair. Wool will be permitted below the hocks and on the head. No wool on the buttocks.
5. Market classes are limited to bona fide members of FFA Chapters, 4-H Clubs, Grange’s and qualified Independent exhibitors in Butte County, or as provided for in the State and local rules.
6. It is the intent of the Division of Fairs and Expositions and of Fairs that the quality standards established for market animals be maintained. Therefore, classifications will be subject to change in the event there are changes made to the Federal grading.
7. After weighing, market lambs will be divided into weight lots as desired by management for convenience in judging.
8. No current evidence of prolapse, including stitches at the time of Fair. During Fair it is Superintendent’s discretion.
9. All State and local rules apply.
10. Ewes entered in the market lamb divisions may not be entered in the breeding divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the Fair.
11. ALL JUNIOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS are required to participate in a certified QUALITY ASSURANCE & ETHICS AWARENESS TRAINING or complete YQCA training (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) and provide current certificate of completion no later than July 27, 2020 or entry will be disqualified. Certification will be verified and if it is not current or valid the entry will be disqualified. YQCA is a national multi-specie assurance program for youth. See YQCA.org for information/certification.
12. A Bill of Sale with the exhibitor’s name and date of purchase of animal. A side view photograph of the exhibitor with the animal, a second photograph including any brands, ear tags, tattoo’s or ear notches that would uniquely identify that animal, verification of the animal’s permanent tag and/or tattoo. This documentation must be submitted via email to livestock@buttecountyfair.org, mailed postmarked by June 29, 2020 or the Fair office by 5pm.
