3. All Color or Black & White photographs minimum size: 8" X 10", maximum size: 16" X 20." Maximum mat size 20" X 24".
4. Photos are to be on Mat Board. Colored, proportional mat board may be used. MATS MUST BE SECURELY ATTACHED. If not, the exhibit will be refused entry.
5. Framed prints will not be accepted. No polaroid prints accepted.
6. The MANAGEMENT reserves the right to remove any item not deemed appropriate for a family based Fair Fine Arts show.
7. Label must be affixed to upper left-hand corner of the back of the entry showing NAME, ADDRESS, and PHONE #
