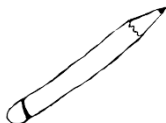
Public can view and listen *without comment*, to the OPEN JUDGING process. If this is not honored you will be asked to leave the building.

4. List the size of the painting or drawing including frame in “description” box of online entry form. (Example: 24”x24”)
5. Names are NOT permitted on front of artwork. NO price tags.
6. Label must be affixed to upper left hand corner of the back of the entry showing ADDRESS, and PHONE #
7. Items will be moved by Fair staff. Fair is not responsible for damage.
8. Fragile or unstable items may be eliminated
9. ANY OTHER classes are for exhibits that do not fit in existing categories, please specify type when entering.
